Trophies are being evaluated while fresh, according to the respective formula of the International Council for Game and Wildlife Conservation (CIC); therefore, 10% are deducted from the weight of red deer, fallow deer and roe deer trophies.

Cloven-hoofed game and bear may only be taken with a rifle. The use of semiautomatic hunting guns and both rifles, is only allowed, if they are loaded with two cartridges at the most. The minimal caliber, bullet weight and hitting power (in Joule) are stated below:

During hunting, the hunting guest has to follow the instructions of his stalking guide and only shoot at the game that he has pointed out. If the hunting guest shoots or wounds a game animal without having obtained the approval from the stalking guide, he has to pay an indemnity, amounting to the double bag fee.

The daily hunting fee covers:  
\* For bear, red deer, roe deer, chamois, mouflon, fallow deer and wild boar hunting - organization of the hunt, admission to the hunting ground, fee for the stalking guide and use of hunting constructions.

Boars and lodging have to be paid for separately. For ordered transportation by car an allowance, amounting to 0,45 €/km has to be paid. Venison of the taken game animals can be purchased at the daily price.

## RED DEER



**Shooting-season: Stag - from 16th August to 31st December; troating from 15th September to 5th October; Hinds and calves - from 1st September to 31st December; Yearling – female and male - from 1st July to 31st December.**

The daily hunting fee amounts to 100 €.

The indemnity for a wounded, yet not found hind or yearling amounts to 250 and for calf 150 €, respectively.

The hunting guest may take with him the trophy and the tushes of the taken stag.



## FALLOW DEER

**Shooting-season: Stag - from 16th August to 31st December; Hinds and calves - from 1st September to 31st December; Yearling – female and male from 1st July to 31st December.**

The daily hunting fee amounts to 50 €.

## ROE DEER



**Shooting-season: Roe-buck and male yearling - from 1st May to 31st October; best hunting season - from 1st May to 15th June and from 1st to 10th August; Does and kids - from 1st September to 31st December; Female yearling - from 1st May to 31st December.**

The daily hunting fee amounts to 100 €.

The indemnity for a wounded, yet not found roe-buck, which the hunting guest has to pay, amounts to 240 €.  
The hunting guest may take with him the trophy of the taken roebuck.

The indemnity for a wounded, yet not found doe or kid amounts to 80 and 50 €, respectively.

## CHAMOIS



**Shooting-season: Buck and doe - from 1st August to 31st December; rutting season - from 1st November to 30th November.**

The indemnity for a wounded, yet not found buck or doe, which the hunting guest has to pay, amounts to 1.000 €. The indemnity for a wounded, yet not found kid amounts to 180 €.  
The hunting guest may take with him the horns and the beard of the taken game.  
If the hunting guest wants to take with him the head incl. chest coat or the entire coat of the taken game, he has to purchase chamois at the daily price.

## MOUFLON



**Shooting-season: ram and lambs - from 1st August to 28th February; ewe - from 1st August to 31st December.**

The daily hunting fee amounts to 100 €.
